



Grant Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in applying for a grant from Ribbons of Hope – Invest in Women, Inc., based in Atlanta, Georgia. We focus on supporting non-profit organizations in Georgia, granting one \$100,000 grant annually. The program/project for which you are seeking funding will improve the lives of women and/or children in one or more of the following areas:

- Health
- Education
- Economic Independence
- Social Well-being
- Human Rights

Before submitting the Grant Application (Round One), please ensure that your organization meets the following criteria:

- Is a 501 (C) (3) organization as determined by the IRS for 3 years or more
- Is an organization that has been in operation for a minimum of 3 years
- Has an annual operating revenue of more than \$500,000 for a minimum of the last 3 years
- Has **not** been awarded a Ribbons of Hope grant within the last 5 years

We do not provide funding for:

- Ongoing operating expenses; however, a small portion of your request may include funding for salaries, marketing, and administrative expenses directly related to your project or program.
- Special Events
- Comprehensive Capital Campaigns
- Micro-enterprise loans
- Private, tuition-based educational institutions, political entities, or religious institutions; however, programs affiliated with such organizations may be considered.
